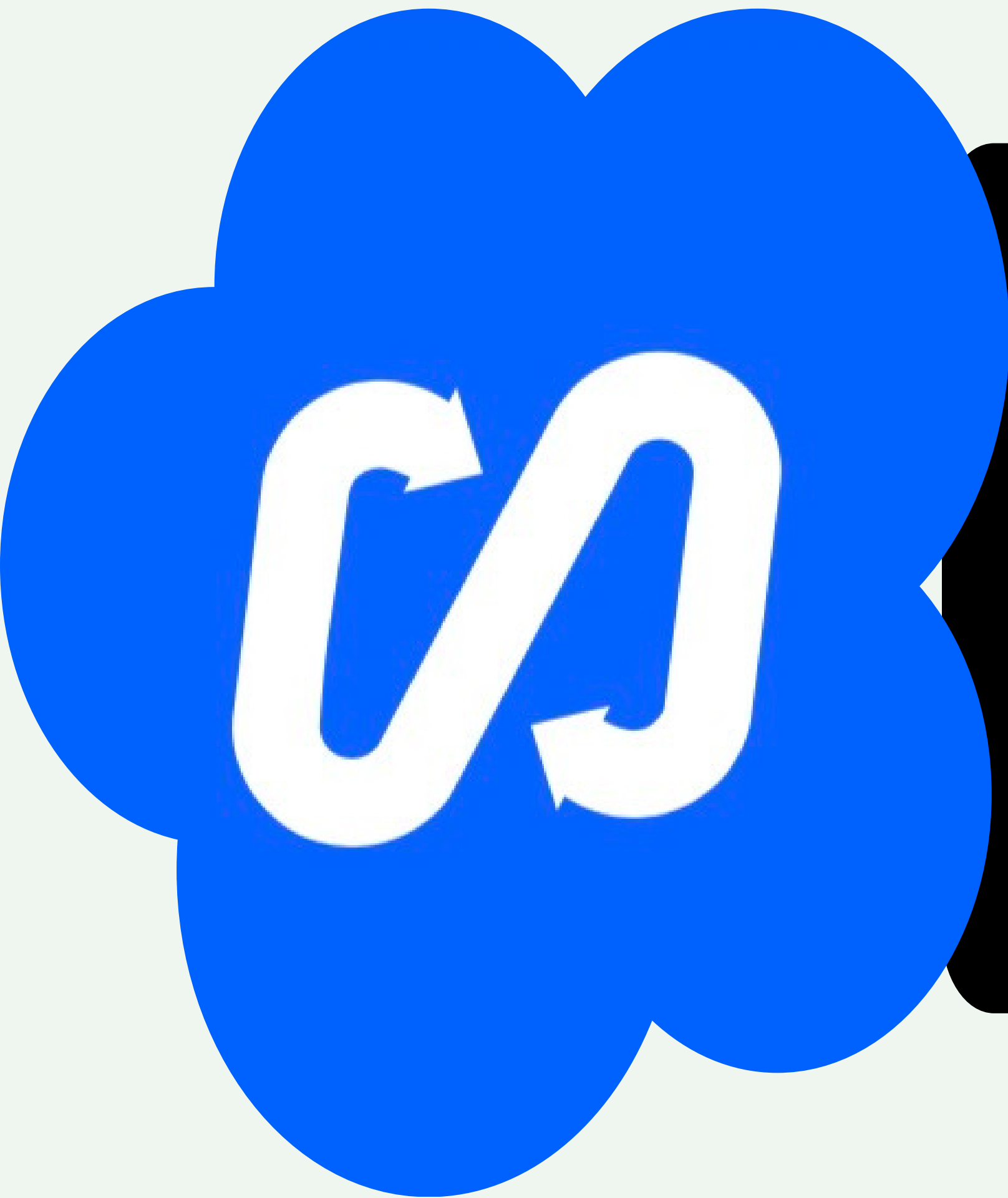

A Message from the Founder

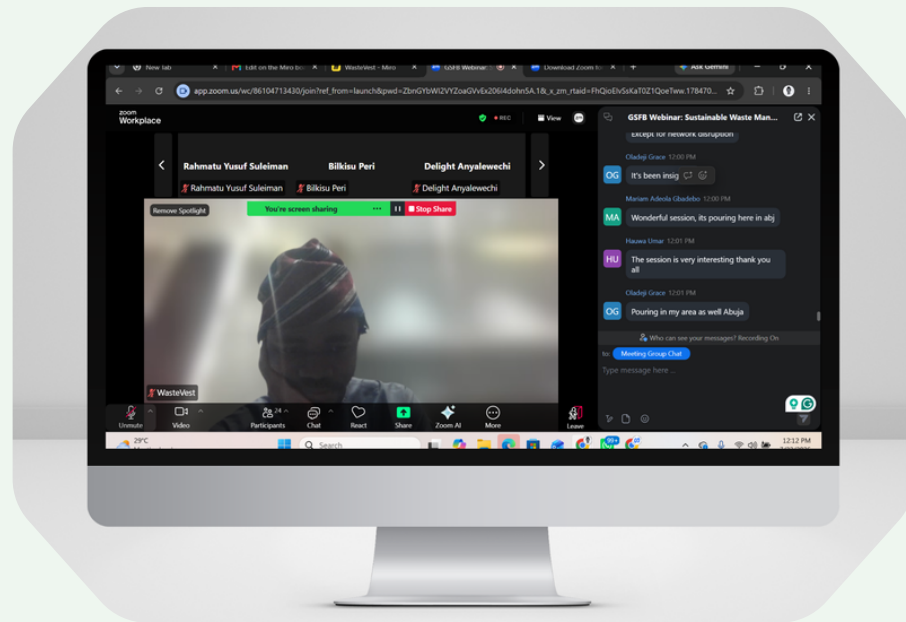
Dear Partners, Supporters, and Friends,

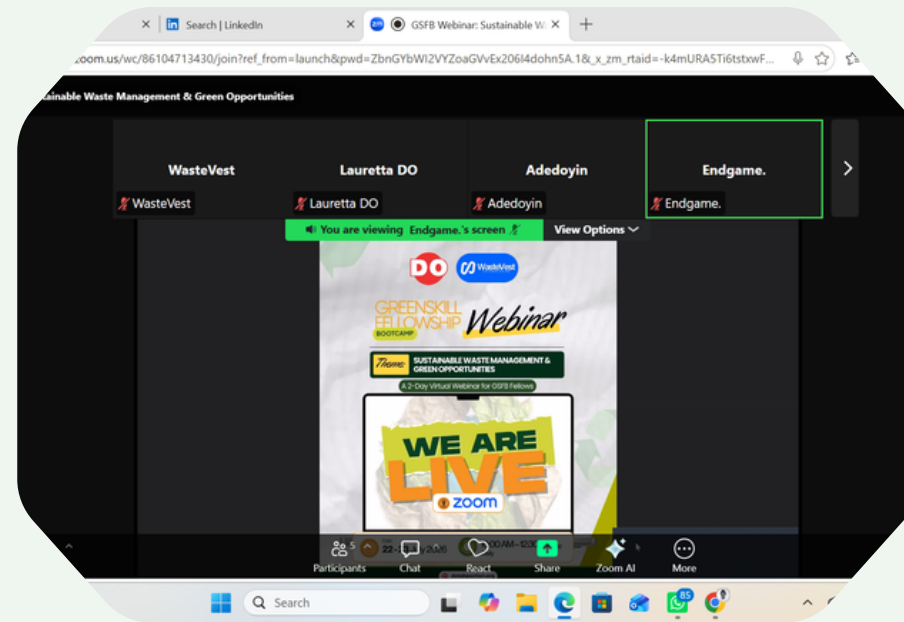

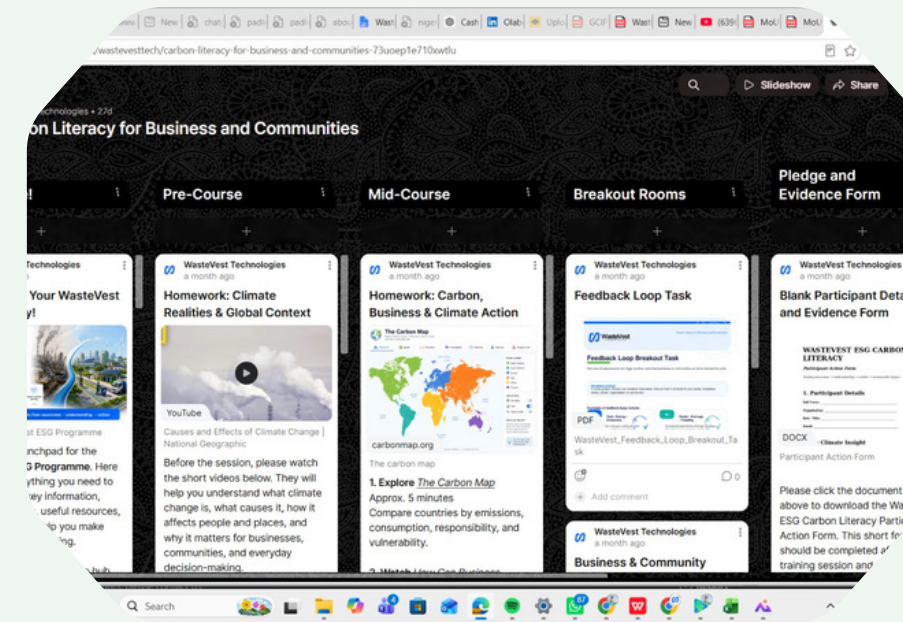

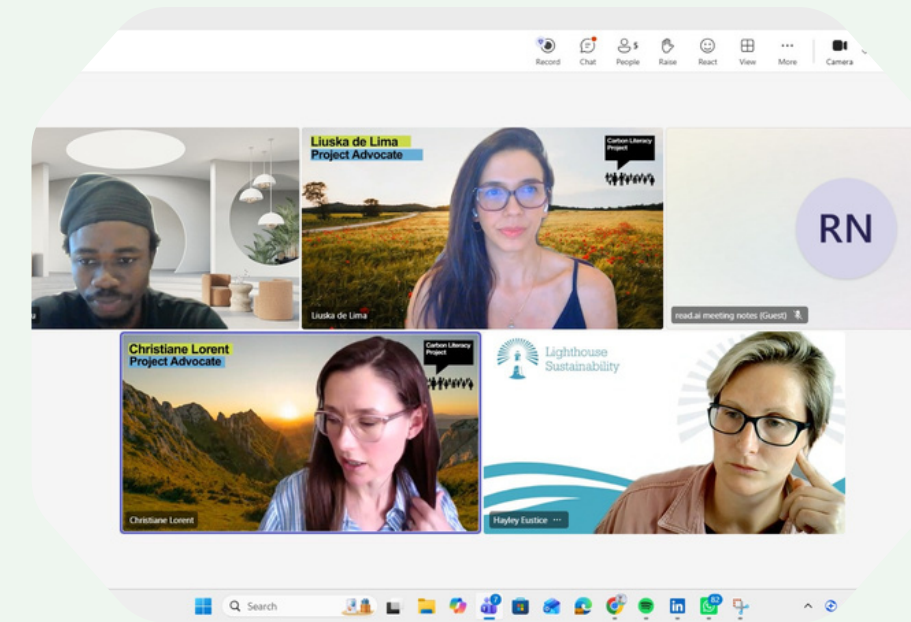
Our work has expanded beyond recycling. Today, WasteVest serves as a platform for climate education, youth engagement, circular economy innovation, and partnership development.

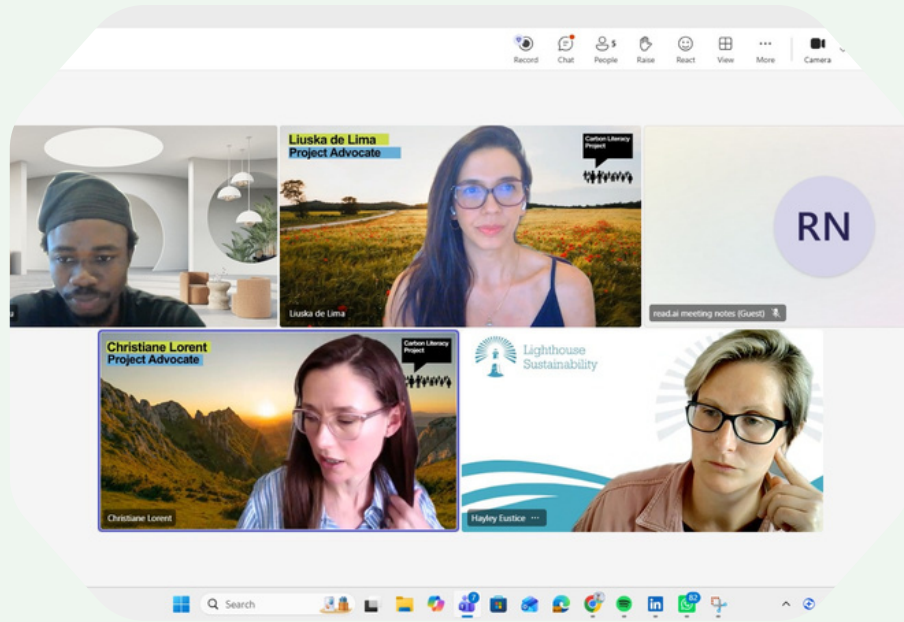

- Sustainable waste management

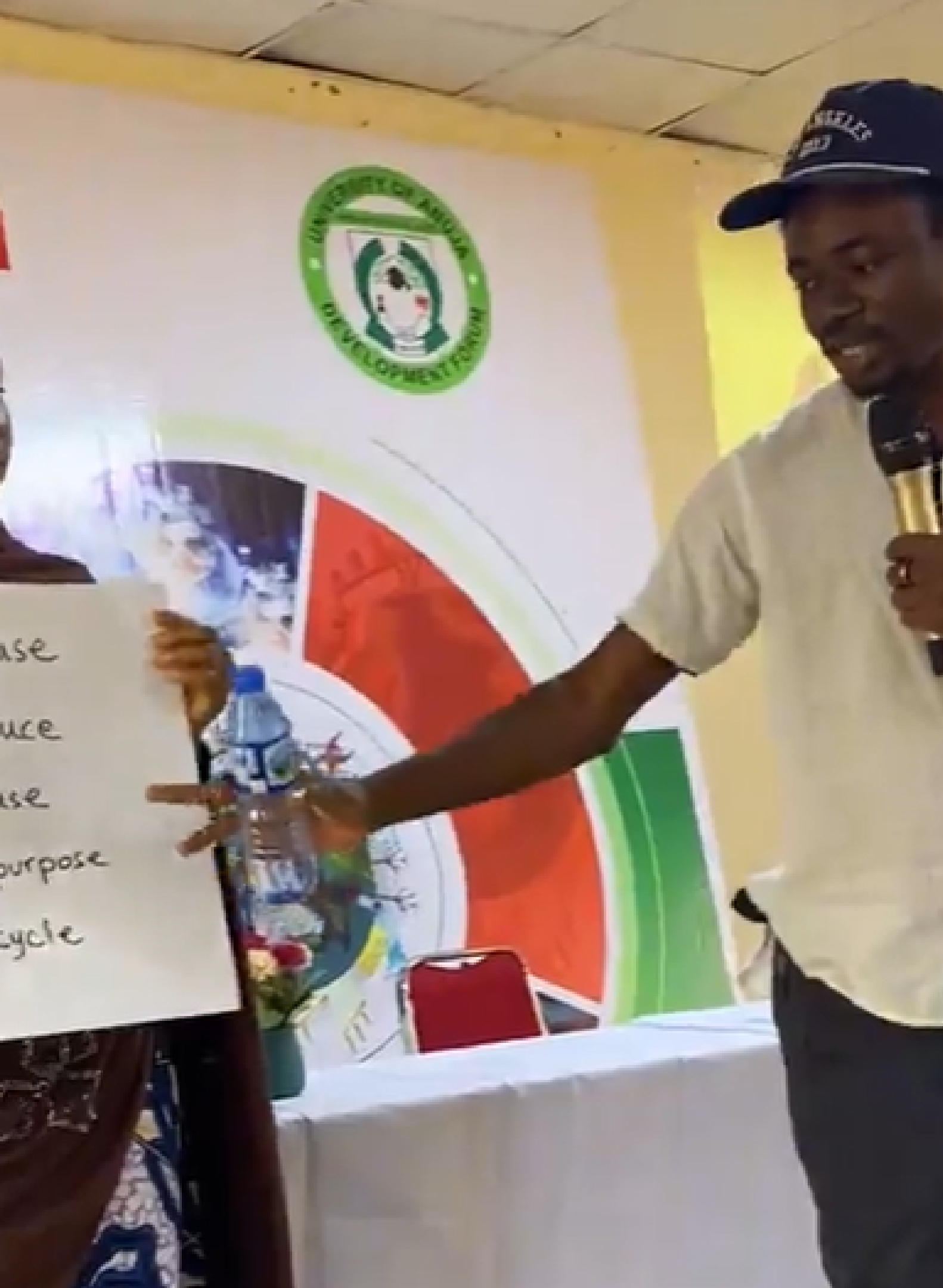


Partnership Development

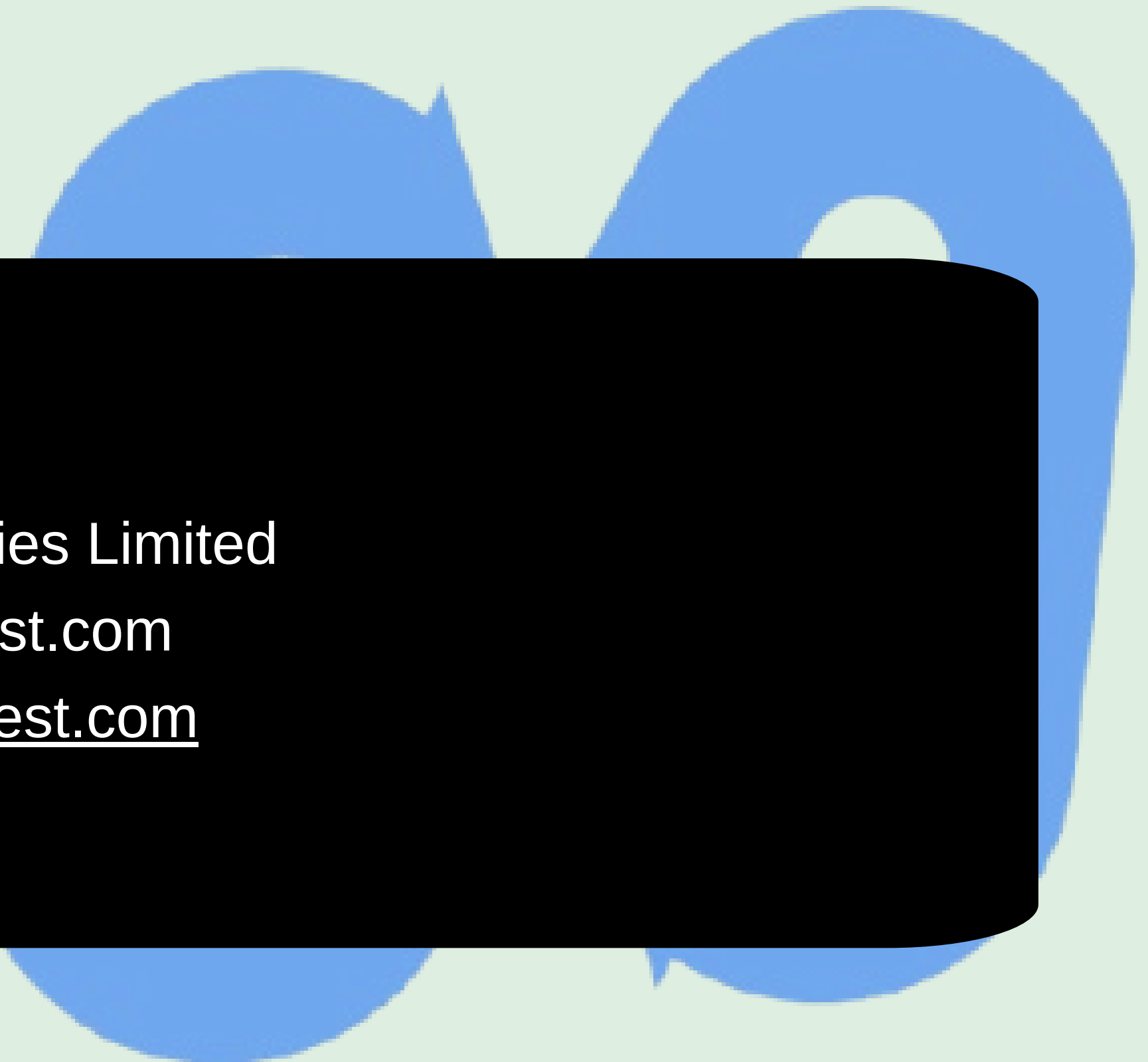
Financial Overview
